Powerful nose with hints of pipped-fruit jam, apples and quince. Rounded and long on the palate, with a succession of apple and pear, fresh fruit fragrances. Persistent bead of bubbles with a creamy mousse. | 1/2 bottle | £46.50

| 5 | Pol Roger Brut Réserve NV, Epernay
An appealing and complex nose of delicate white flowers, green apples and brioche. Stone fruit flavours on the palate with hints of nuttiness and honey. | | £60.45 |
| 6 | Bollinger Rosé NV, Aÿ
Dry, powerful and very serious indeed, this highly polished rosé combines notes of plum, patisserie, cinnamon and spice. With structure and weight and harmony of vibrant flavours right across the palate, this is a delicious accompaniment that can match a variety of dishes. | | £73.95 |
| 7 | Pol Roger Vintage 2008, Epernay
An attractive deep golden colour with a continuous thread of lingering bubbles. The nose is powerful and complex, revealing the maturity of the wine, developing aromas of quince and apple, combined with richer notes of dried fruits. The palate shows a creamy, voluptuous and well-balanced structure with an aftertaste of almonds and citrus freshness. | | £99.95 |

| 8 | Chenin Blanc 2016, Simonsvlei, Western Cape, South Africa
Ripe tropical fruit aromas, especially guava and pineapple, complemented by hints of lemon. Good balance of fruit and acidity, followed by a fresh, zesty finish. | £3.60/£5.10/£7.20 | £21.00 |
| 9 | Pinot Grigio 2016, È 100, Veneto, Italy
A lovely floral aroma, with masses of fresh fruit flavours on the palate and a rush of crisp citrus acidity, making it perfectly balanced and totally refreshing. | £4.20/£5.70/£8.30 | £22.60 |
| 10 | Picpoul de Pinet 2016, Domaine Langaran, Languedoc, France
Gentle and refreshing with notes of Mediterranean white peach, apricot kernel and zesty lime peel culminating in a silky mouth-feel and crisp, vibrant acidity. | | £25.00 |
| 11 | Sauvignon Blanc 2016, Bascand, New Zealand
Aromas of pineapple and fresh cut grass. The palate is rich with good texture and fine acidity. | £4.90/£6.95/£9.70 | £27.50 |
| 12 | Gavi 2016, Pier Carlo Bergaglio, Italy
Light straw in colour, fresh aromas followed by a rich body and long finish. dry, fresh, harmonious. Perfectly structured. | | £27.25 |
| 13 | Sauvignon Blanc 2015, Pfandturm, Rhienhessen, Germany
Clear and fruity with gooseberries, some citrus and bright blossoms and a hint of herbs; slightly sweet, alive fresh and direct. | | £28.95 |
| 14 | Albariño 2016, Liebre y la Tortuga, Rias Baixas, Spain
Aromas of citrus fruits with notes of fennel and passion fruit. On the palate it is fruity but fresh, with an intense leafy character and exotic notes. Finishes ultra tangy and fresh. | | £29.95 |
| 15 | Gewürztraminer Reserve 2015, Cave Hunawihl, Alsace, France
The nose is very complex with very delicate perfumes of lychee, mango and particularly rose. Full-bodied, this off dry wine has a refreshing acidity with roses lingering on the long finish. | | £31.45 |
| 16 | Chardonnay 'Morning Fog' 2015, Wente, California, USA
Green apple and tropical fruit aromas and flavours. Oak, cinnamon and vanilla hints from oak ageing. Mouth filling body with good, balanced acidity. | | £32.45 |

White Wines

- 17 Rioja Blanco 2015, Tobelos, Spain £35.85
Good intensity of clean ripe citrus fruit, pleasant toasty oak and smoked notes. Dry, light, with balanced fruit and wood assemblage, broadening out on the palate and leaving a lingering refreshing taste of toasty ripe fruit.
- 18 Pouilly Fumé 2016, Domaine du Petit Soumard, Loire, France £37.85
Smoked aromas and scents of gooseberry and grass. The palate is clean and crisp with notes of white melon, lime and grapefruit.
- 19 Semillon/Sauvignon 'Siblings' 2014, Leeuwin Estate, Australia £41.85
Savoury, fragrant and complex. The palate has a soft, integrated and textural entry; figs, quince, lemon flesh and Golden Delicious apples. A touch of cream and sweet spice provide a three-dimensional palate.
- 20 Vouvray 2015, Sébastien Brunet, Loire, France £48.85
A delicious fruit driven aroma with subtle hints of honey. The palate is much more linear, giving some bright fresh citrus and then some apricots coming out on the end.
- 21 Saskia 2013, Miles Mossop, South Africa £50.25
A blend of Chenin Blanc and Viognier with a little Verdehlo and Clairette Blanche. Aromas of white peach, toasted brioche, ripe grilled pineapples and a hint of white pepper spice. A full mid-palate of honeysuckle and dried apricot. The finish is dry and textured with a hint of toastiness.
- 22 Chablis 1er Cru 'Le Lys' 2015, Sébastien Dampt, Burgundy, France £54.75
A cool climate Chablis with good minerality. The vines are sixty years old which gives concentration and a lovely aromatic nose. The palate has a beautiful saline mineral quality and a classic fresh acidity.
- 23 Sancerre 'Le Monts Damnés' 2013, Francois Cotat, Loire, France £62.85
Spicy nose of wild flowers and pepper makes way for a salty, citrus-inspired mouth, suggesting candied lemons, poached white fruits and energetic pepper.
- 24 Viognier 2013, Cristom Estate, Oregon, USA £70.95
Aromatic wine rolls into a gorgeous palate loaded with rich fruit flavours of pineapple, grapefruit and Meyer lemon. There is a suggestion of softness to the acids, and a lick of butterscotch runs through the finish.
- 25 Puligny Montrachet 2014, Joseph Drouhin, Burgundy, France £98.55
A wine of great finesse, distinguished and elegant. The aromas evoke trees in bloom and white flesh fruit, like white peaches. On the palate, there is a sensation of fresh silkiness. Long and persistent in the aftertaste, ending on an exceptional wealth of flavours, both floral and fruity.

Red Wines

- 26 Merlot 2016, Reserve St Marc, Languedoc, France £3.60/£5.10/£7.10 £21.50
A dark garnet red colour with a fruity nose, mixed with spicy notes of thyme and pepper.
- 27 Aga Tinto 2015, Navarra, Spain £4.35/£6.20/£8.65 £23.50
Medium ageing in oak barrels. The nose is crisp and clear, with large presence of fresh fruits and flowers notes. The mouth is smooth with sweet tannins. The finish is long and very pleasant.
- 28 Pinot Noir Reserva 2016, Pacifico Sur, Chile £22.95
Aromas of cherries and raspberries with soft notes of oak. The palate is smooth with elegant tannins followed by a sophisticated finish.
- 29 Shiraz 2015, Cranswick Estate, Barossa, Australia £25.00
Berry fruit, plums and spicy mocha chocolate oak aromas on the nose. with savoury stewed cherry and blackcurrant flavours on the palate.
- 30 Malbec 2015, Los Haroldos, Mendoza, Argentina £4.90/£6.95/£9.70 £27.50
Plum, damson and black cherry fruit aromas. The palate is mid weight with smooth, soft tannins. The finish shows berry fruit and a hint of spice.
- 31 Chianti Colli Senesi 2015, Borghesi, Tuscany, Italy £27.25
Gentle, fresh, and harmonic thanks to an appropriate balance of alcohol, tannins, and acidity and it persists a long time on the palate.
- 32 Côtes du Rhône Garrigue 2014, Domaine de la Renjarde, Rhône, France £30.95
Intense notes of red and black fruits and Provençal fragrances of rosemary and black olive.
- 33 Zinfandel 2013, Wente, California, USA £31.75
Strawberry and dark fruit aromas with hints of cinnamon, vanilla and cherry. Mouth filling dark fruit flavours with spice.
- 34 Fleurie 2015, Montangeron, Beaujolais, France £31.75
Elegant and velvety in texture with characteristic perfumed aromas of delicate floral notes and ripe red berries. Good weight and depth with soft blackcurrant and subtle violet notes throughout lead to long silky finish.

Red Wines

- 35 Cabernet Franc 2016, Serbal, Argentina £38.55
Intense and elegant. Excellent structure with plenty of concentration of red fruits and peppers. Great balance and aromatic on the nose. Medium to full body.
- 36 Rioja Reserva 1999, Bodegas Urbina, Rioja, Spain £39.50
A classic spicy mature Rioja aroma but still with a wealth of fruit. On the palate there is an intensity of stewed autumn fruits, combined with sweet spice. The texture is soft and smooth with a lingering finish.
- 37 Château Labadie 2012, Médoc, Bordeaux, France £40.25
Deep red with hints of purple, strong aromas of fig and ripe black fruit. Well-rounded palate with good volume and a great aromatic finish.
- 38 Max 2014, Miles Mossop, Stellenbosch, South Africa £45.75
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Merlot and Malbec, this Bordeaux blend has aromas of dark cherries, Christmas cake and a hint of roasted fennel bulb and five spices aromas. The palate is full, rich, lingering and dry, packed with flavours of dark cherries, plums, cassis and mulberries. The tannins are firm and dry which offers an exceptionally long finish.
- 39 Woodcutters Shiraz 2014, Torbreck, Barossa, Australia £45.75
Blackberry, floral notes and a hint of spice. Full bodied, rich and opulent, this wine combines great fruit purity with texture, complexity, finesse and a long finish.
- 40 Amarone 'Coste Bianchi' 2011, Tenute Fiorebelli, Veneto, Italy £62.85
Aromas and flavours of black cherries, chocolate, coffee and raisins, along with a note of almond. Despite a formidable structure, the palate is velvety, spicy and elegant with an extremely long and lingering finish.
- 41 Château Grand Pey Lescours 2004, St Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France £62.85
Red berry fruit flavours with vanilla and coffee notes. Followed by raspberries, red berries and chocolate on the palate and silky tannins.
- 42 Chambolle Musigny VV 2013, Domaine Stephane Magnien, Burgundy, France £92.85
Juniper, smoked bacon, jammy black cherries, and spices. A deep, concentrated, plush, broad wine, it slathers the palate with sensual waves of red and black fruits that linger throughout its exceptionally long finish. Medium to full-bodied, harmonious, and intense.

Rosé Wines

- 43 Pinot Grigio Blush 2016, Viamora, Italy £3.85/£5.45/£7.65 £22.50
Copper with rosy tinges. This is a fruity, intense wine with full harmonic flavours.
- 44 Château St Louis 2016, Provence, France £26.25
The nose is dominated by candied fruit, apricot and passionfruit. Powerful on the palate, it finishes with stewed and ripe fruit.

Dessert Wines

- 45 Samos Vin Doux NV, Greece £3.75 £15.95
A beautifully balanced dessert wine. Aromas of apricot jam, over-ripe melon and butterscotch candy.
- 46 Château Filhot 2011, Sauternes, Bordeaux, France £8.85 £38.85
Medium bodied, with an orange, apricot, pineapple and honeysuckle. bottle
- 47 Red Muscadel 2014, Nuy Winery, Worcester, South Africa £3.95 £33.55
Typical raisin flavours and distinctive muscat aromas. Great with chocolate desserts and cheeses.

Port

- 48 Niepoort Ruby Dum £3.60 £23.15
Dark fruit aromas which follow through on the palate. A youthful wine with great balance.
- 49 Niepoort Tawny Dee £3.60 £23.15
Delicate nutty aromas and a hint of dried fruit. The palate is very well balanced with a fruity, luscious character, which intergrates well with a long spirity finish.
- 50 Graham's Malvedos 2004 £38.85
Jammy blackberry and blueberry scents, combined with seductive floral hints. The palate is packed with solid, structured, rich and intense black fruit flavours, showing impressive intensity and sweetness leading to a very long lingering finish.
